Dear Sir / Madam,

As part of the Leeds Site Allocation Plan public consultation process, I would like to formally object to the proposed development of the following sites:

HG2-41

HG2-42

HG2-43

HG2-12

It is my understanding that the proposed development sites are NOT consistent with the national policy, specifically with regard to Green Belt. Leeds must continue to protect our Green Belt and green fields.

The fields and open green spaces, which are being proposed for development, are important to me because they are an area of particular beauty, including the strawberry fields which are very popular, and wonderful views from the side of the valley. Perhaps more importantly, these areas will add significantly to the problems of traffic. Despite the recent changes to the ring road access at Horsforth and Rodley roundabouts it is still a bottleneck area. The building of new properties will make the traffic problems much worse.

These sites should continue to be part of Leeds' 'Strategic Green Infrastructure' as identified in the Adopted Core Strategy.

It is my understanding that the proposed development sites are NOT consistent with the national planning policy framework, specifically with regard to infrastructure. Leeds has insufficient policies in place to address the issues that these developments will generate. Development and infrastructure requirements must be considered side by side.

Please keep me informed of the public examinations, submission of the plans and potential outcome of the review as I would like to retain my right to attend and speak.
