Dear Counsellors

With reference to the above housing application, I would like to confirm some of the problems that you are already aware of.

On occasions recently I had to travel along Wood Lane towards the A61 Wood Lane junction at about 8.45 am. This took from Low Shops Lane approximately 15 minutes. At other time of the day i.e. 10.30 am, this journey takes 3 or 4 minutes. I would like also to confirm problems when trying to ascertain book appointments at the surgery that my husband and I use (New Cross Surgery). By increasing the population with this new build, new doctors would be required, an additional school for the 4 - 11 year-olds, because at the moment people are having to travel to Carlton from this area for schooling.

One of our main concerns is the lack of facilities at this end of Rothwell and the vast amount of traffic congestion this would cause.

We have always been under the impression that these fields were green belt areas so if this builds has to go ahead, we need a guarantee that a new school and doctors surgeries are built at the same time.
