Dear Sir/Madam,

Being a local Horsforth resident, I am responding to the proposed Leeds Site Allocation Plans affecting Horsforth and Rawdon and wish to confirm my concerns and objections to the following sites.

HG2-43 Horsforth College Campus.

This is a predominately greenfield site in a strategic location with level playing field areas and nature reserve. With nearby schools (eg Newlathes) already overstretched, this site should be retained for educational use. I believe to saturate this strategically important site with housing goes against the Leeds Core Strategy and is inconsistent with the National Planning Policy Framework.

HG2-41 Fields south of A65 from Horsforth roundabout to Rawdon Crematorium.

This site is entirely greenfield and over 700 houses will have a seismic impact both environmentally and on the A65/ring road infrastructure which is unlikely to cope. The full impact of the adjoining Clariant HG1-96/97 brownfield conversion to housing has yet to be felt and it is therefore unjustified and premature to propose and impose the conversion of a greenfield site of twice the size next door.

Again, the proposal to include this site in the Local Plan is inconsistent with the National Planning Policy Framework and goes against the Leeds Core Strategy.

I am sure I will be one of many with similar concerns and request that due consideration is taken to review and amend these site allocations.
