Re- the above.

I wish to register an objection to the proposed building at the above site for the following reasons

1/ With regard to road safety ... The access to and from , via Church Lane is unsuitable for an increased volume of traffic - Church Lane itself , at that point, is fairly steep and near to an almost blind bend. The increased congestion , esp on a morning, will cause a build-up of traffic waiting to enter onto Church Lane from adjacent streets - this needs to be considered as many children walk along Church Lane to get to local schools.

2/ Loss of green space and impact ... A better use (e.g allotments) could be found for this land- a housing estate would spoil completely the view of the beautiful Victorian church (a listed building) and make it look very hemmed in. The character of Meanwood does not, in my opinion, lend itself to more houses being built.

3/ The plans state that the site is suitable for 'older persons' housing', but that 'other types won't be ruled out ? This is rather vague and definitely needs clarifying further; e.g - luxury housing , social housing ?
