I am a Guiseley resident writing to you to express concern about the intended building plans for the Ings area of Guiseley.

The area itself is a much cherished area of green belt countryside where we walk regularly... its a peaceful stretch of an increasingly busy Guiseley and Menston that can be walked to rather than having to get to by car.

The A65 which my wife and myself have to use every day is a nightmare of congestion as it is... we don't have the option to use public transport as it can't deliver us to our work on time or reliably. We both set off to work at 6.15 am, anything after this time and it can take well over an hour for us to travel 10 miles. Further building along the A65 will only increase this situation.

We don't even attempt to get a Doctors appointment at the Netherfield Rd surgery in Guiseley anymore as there are never any free appointments.
We don't go to the local Westside Retail park any longer as congestion and road rage is not unusual there as the car park regularly reaches saturation and gridlock.

Please consider the existing residents quality of life.... I realise homes need to be built but the quantity of traffic through Guiseley is getting unbearable. Thank you.
