I work in Halifax and my route is through the Horsforth and Rodley roundabouts. We have suffered at a year of least of disruption in these (and downstream) areas and the Horsforth roundabout changes have not made any difference to congestion in the morning rush hour. Addition residences in this area will just add to the chaos.
