I am writing with my concerns over the proposed plans to build 155 houses on the above site adjacent to the A65. I live in St Johns Way and commute to Leeds and back everyday by bus. While I imagine that most people who buy the new houses probably won't use this service as they will be bringing their cars with them I must point out that the traffic on this route is already at gridlock, especially the section between Rawdon traffic lights to Guiseley (exactly where you are planning to let them build more houses!).

I realise that this proposal is already cut and dried but it beggars belief that councillors who have been voted in by the local community can then turn around and completely ignore the wishes of that community.

It also strikes me as underhand to allow the builders to present their traffic survey taken during school half term when everyone knows the traffic is less dense. You should have insisted they do it on a normal school day when it can take nearly as long to get from Rawdon to Guiseley as it does from the centre of Leeds to Rawdon. I imagine none of the people on the planning board live in the surrounding area or you would not even be considering this ridiculous plan.
