Dear Sir.

I wish to register my protest at the councils plans for new homes adjacent to the A65 at Rawdon and Horsforth.

Whoever has thought up this scheme has obviously not travelled on the A65 lately. The traffic situation is horrendous. At 11am today, 30th October 2015, there was a queue approximately 1 mile long towards the Horsforth roundabout from the direction of Rawdon. A similar situation will occur again at around 5pm when traffic will be stationary to the roundabout for well over 1 mile, and beyond where I live on Layton Park Drive. This, in spite of a recently completed overall of the roundabout with new traffic lights installed at what cost!!

To now put in the region of 1000 new homes needing access to this road is completely unthinkable. Where are all the vehicles belonging to these homes going to go as there is no other access road for them.

This does not even take into account the loss of green belt land, which is green belt for a good reason and should not be just wiped out, or the impact on local schools which do not have the capacity to cope with it.
