I am writing to complain regarding the site allocations for housing in Rawdon/Horsforth areas. Especially HG3-4, HG3-2, HG3-3 and HG2-12.

I do not feel that the total number of proposed housing is justified and your plans go against national policy to only build on brownfield and greenfield sites. Maybe you should remove the term Greenbelt from the dictionary as it obviously does not mean anything different to Brownfield or Greenfield sites.

If all your housing development goes ahead, the area will be choked, Rawdon and Horsforth will be merged and we will simply become a suburb of Leeds. The whole character of these areas will be lost forever. I do not see how the main A65 road could cope with the massive increase in vehicular activity and the existing network is severely problematic already, not to mention schools, shops, doctors and dentist facilities.

I strongly object to such a vast expansion of housing in this area and sincerely hope my views will be taken into consideration.
