I would like to register my objection to the assignment of sites HG2-41(4240) and HG2 - 42 (1016) for potential development.

I am a resident of Calverley Lane and would therefore be affected greatly by the development of these sites.

I am acutely aware that we have a nation wide housing shortage, hence had no objection to development of the Clariant factory, Calverley Lane.

I do however argue that our local road network can not support an influx of additional cars. The roads are currently overly congested, with the token 'improvements' to the roundabouts having little impact. A large housing estate would congest the infrastructure further, resulting to further economic and environmental loss.

Greenbelt land is set aside to protect nature and keep towns and villages distinct. I fear the development of the land could critically damage the wildlife we see daily, including birds, bats, hedgehogs, deer and foxes.

I urge you to meet the housing targets by first utilising all the brownfield sites available and renovating the decrepit areas of Leeds before you forever ruin our beautiful Greenbelt areas.
