Your plans on building 130 houses on the HG2-12 land (next to Woodlands Drive) is widely disagreed with throughout our neighbourhood. I live on Woodlands Drive with my family and , I would like to be proud of my area in the future and if these development plans persist I will not.

I feel as though this development at HG2-12 and around that area, will destroy the peaceful atmosphere and crowd the roads nearby even more than they already are. I have been going through the roundabout (where the ring road crosses the A65) everyday travelling to school and back. The recent upgrade on that particular roundabout was caused because of the sheer amount of traffic- won't the large number of extra veicles effect it even more? Even worse, with a new school being planned at HG2-41, the A65 would be gridlocked in mornings and evenings. Wildlife is probably something that most people regard as 'not important' but if you actually think about it, you are placing 130 houses at HG2-12 - that's basically 130 habitats - I thought Rawdon was a 'GREEN' area! Furthermore, I feel as though the community nearby has not been informed properly (by the council) or asked whether we agree or not, the only information we have received is by the protesters who also have their opinions.

I realise that we need more accommodation for people, but you're not thinking enough about how it can affect others! I hope you will think again about your plans at HG2-12 and also your building ideas around that neck-of-the-woods.
