Dear Sir/madam,

I am writing in order to object to the Leeds Site Allocation Plans and specifically the plans to develop housing on a number of sites in and around Horsforth.

These are Hg2-41 (4240), Hg2-43 (5009), Hg2-42 (1016) and Hg-12 (4254).

I feel that the plans to build in these areas contravene the national planning policy framework by encroaching on Green Belt land and will destroy important wildlife habitats. There has not been any information given by the council explaining why these areas must be developed as opposed to other brownfield sites or areas where there is housing stock standing empty. I do not feel it has been shown there is an exceptional need to build on these particular sites.

All these areas are already situated in an area where there is frequent congestion and traffic bottlenecks. Our local gp surgeries and schools are already over-subscribed and there has been no explanation of how these things will be addressed.

I write as a Horsforth resident, residing at 33 Victoria drive, ls18 4pn. My children attend local schools, we use the gp surgery on New Road Side and I commute to work by bus on the busy A65.
