Please note my objection to the plans to build in the following sites:

HG2-41 (4240)
HG2-42 (1016)
HG2-43 (5009)
HG2-12 (4254)

The plans breach National Planning Policy which states that our Greenbelt should be preserved to maintain wildlife, the green spaces and individual communities.

I have lived in Horsforth since 1972, there is a strong community spirit and Horsforth has its own identity. Excessive building development will destroy the community spirit and Horsforth will lose its identity

There are sufficient brownfield areas suitable for development and there are many areas in North Leeds where building development could be undertaken without destroying the protected Greenbelt.

All of the roads around Horsforth are heavily congested and the West End area is gridlocked every morning when commuters drive down West End Lane to avoid Rawdon Road. This is a residential area and the traffic congestion is hazardous, with many cars exceeding the speed limit. I know the police are aware of this problem and the Police Community Support Officers are monitoring the situation. There is an infants school in this area and the roads are now becoming dangerous for children and young mums.

The current residential development on the former Sandos sight will result I even more congestion.

I am proud to live at Horsforth and value the areas heritage. The green belt make Horsforth a very pleasant area to live in. To allow development of our green belt will permanently damage the character and heritage of Horsforth.
