I wish to strongly object to the plans relating to the above Reference numbers. My grounds for objection are mainly related to congestion.

I have regular need to drive from Rawdon via the JCT roundabout along the A65. between 8am and 9am I find it impossible to progress my journey at more than an average of 8mph between The JCT roundabout and Guiseley. The same traffic conditions are repeated later in the day. I am fearful that any additional housing along this route will inevitably make the problem worse.

In addition getting a Doctors appointment has become more difficult in recent years due to the increased number of patients signing on with local practices.

Schools do not have the number of vacancies that would be required should all these proposed houses be constructed.

Individual villages will simply become one without any spaces between to separate one from another (Greenbelt)

Having worked as a community nurse for a number of years I am aware of numerous sites across the city i.e derelict or run down areas recognised as brown field sites and needing development. Now I recognise that not everyone wants to live on these sites but they will require development anyway and may as well be in housing.

The building of more homes in the areas proposed should not proceed until the infrastructure is there to provide for their needs.
