I tried the Council website and could not access the web address provided on the letter re above subject so I am emailing you both in the hope that my concerns will be put forward to appropriate places.

I would like to list my concerns in connection with proposed development in Rothwell and why I am **TOTALLY AGAINST** all plans for the development and that the concerns of the current residents should be **SERIOUSLY** taken into account before any plans to develop the proposed sites in Rothwell.

1. The bus service is already not sufficient and reliable for current population and also too expensive for the poor service that ARRIVA provide. It is definatley not worth the money that we are charged to use public transport which is such a poor service.
2. Heavy traffic on Wood Lane on a morning and evening there is already a heavy build up of traffic at rush hour which can take up to an hour and longer in poor weather conditions and there is always a build up at Arla and onto motorway and into Stourton . It already causes many problems and stress when travelling into work and this will only get worse with increase in population.
3. Doctor and Dental Surgeries not sufficient at present due to high demand and to get an appointment and or registration. You cannot plan your illness or Dental problems you should be able to get an appointment when necessary. This personally causes me much stress

when you are not feeling well and need to see a Doctor or Dentist.

4. Increase in buildings will cause air pollution and increase traffic and Rothwell will lose the village feel it still maintains.

5. The infrastructure of Rothwell will not be able to cope with the proposed changes and I do not think the proposed plans have been well thought out and discussed with current residents. We already pay high council tax and services are poor at present that needs to be improved for current residents and improve quality of life for us.

Thus again I would be grateful if my concerns would be put forward to council and I will appreciate any updates.
