Dear Mr Bondi,

Thank you for your emails. The site came into being as a result of a representation during the Issues and Options consultation. It was one of a list of sites suggested in a report entitled 'Horsforth Town Council Community Consultation on Leeds City Council Strategic Housing Land Availability Assessment Sites Summary of Responses May 2013'. Within this document the results of one of the survey questions was given as below - (Question 4) '4. Are there any sites or buildings not shown on the map that you think should be considered for housing development in Horsforth?' A list was then presented of a number of sites including the one you refer to. It was recorded as a new site – Site 13 South of the A65 from Horsforth RAB to Rawdon Crematorium – in Leeds City Council's draft Report of Consultation Paragraph 6.86.

With regard to your objection to the proposed density and phase of the site, this will be added as a representation to the plan and considered in due course.
