**WE STRONGLY OBJECT TO THE PLANS HG2-41 RAWDON
CREMATORIUM TO HORSFORTH ROUNDABOUT 777 HOUSES AND
SCHOOL**

We are very concerned re the above planning application for 777 new homes and School to be built on The Rawdon Crematorium to Horsforth Roundabout Reference HG2-41.

We believe the plans are not justified as they depend to heavily on Green Belt land instead of alternative sites. There have been considerable alterations since the first draft site allocations, including the introduction of large Green Belt sites in this area. We believe their use conflicts with national policy as well as Leeds own policy and cannot be justified.

Brown field sites:- Are available else ware across LEEDS. LCC Core Strategy says itself that all these must be developed before greenbelt land.

There has been no consideration of proposed Airport Link Road. On which a decision is due soon. This would link settlements of Yeadon Rawdon and Horsforth, yet it has not been considered by LCC when deciding where to put houses.

A65 over capacity. Concentrating more developments along A65 is unsustainable, dangerous and would be a disaster for area. HG2-41 with a school would cause further gridlock on the ring road. Local roads are too busy drivers using them as a rat run to airport .

Strategic Green Infastructure of Aire Valley would be forever LOST. Restricting enjoyment of the lovely area for walking cycling horse riding and harming nature ecology.

We strongly object to the plans for HG2-41 .
