Message : Dear Sirs, I attended the Site Allocations Plan Exhibition Programme in Pudsey on Wednesday, 30th.September and was dismayed to see that ref. 4046, also marked as HG2-65,is earmarked for a development of 89 units. This particular area is the only (and last)greenfield site separating Leeds from Bradford, and as such, should be left as it is, otherwise there will be no separation of Leeds from Bradford. I do not think the Council has fully explored brownfield sites within the city of Leeds thoroughly enough, and I give as an example the Garnet Grove/Garnet Terrace area in Beeston, where it appears that many back-to-back houses have been demolished, and is now just waste land (and an eyesore to boot!). There must be many other places like this that could be built upon without the need to resort to encroaching on greenfield sites, of which there are too few left (alas!).
