I write in respect of the above existing greenfield sites. as a resident I am extremely concerned about the proposed change in status to housing sites. My main concerns are as follows:

The detrimental affect to the historical architectural heritage of Woodlands Drive, once the home of mill owners is now going to be shadowed by design deficient housing with no doubt, a percentage being allocated to social housing. Woodlands Drive and the Cragg Wood Drive are lucky enough to be relatively a low crime area, an increase in housing will encourage an increase in crime,

The deer that freely roam in this area will be driven out of their natural habitats, with the noise pollution which goes hand in hand with construction work.

The fields which are being proposed will have to be dug up and levelled before any construction work takes place which will change the landscape for all those in the area. The fields are marsh land with poor drainage once redeveloped what will happen to the excess water as runs freely on to woodlands drive - will the council be paying for the resurfacing as the road erodes away or will the residents be footing the bill!!
