I wish to register my objection to the site allocations planned for the Horsforth and Rawdon areas.

My main objection is that the largest site allocations are all within Green Belt areas. These are HG2-41, HG2-43, HG2-12, HG3-2, HG3-3 and HG3-4. This is not consistent with NPPF national and local policy. One of the purposes of Green Belt is to prevent neighbouring towns from merging into one another. Building on HG2-41, HG2-12, HG3-2 and HG3-3 would serve to merge Horsforth and Rawdon and would completely spoil the character of the area.

Finally, with regard to the target of 70,000 houses, this figure is based on out of date statistics and is considerably over-estimated.
