RE: LEEDS SITE ALLOCATION PLANS – FORMAL OBJECTION

10th November 2015

To Whom it may concern.

As part of the Leeds Site Allocation Plan public consultation process, I would like to formally object to the proposed development of the following site:-

HG2-41 (4240) Fields South of A65 from Horsforth & Rawdon RA to crematorium
HG2-42 (1016) Fields at Broadway and Calverley lane Horsforth
HG2-43 (Fields at Horsforth Campus)

It is my understanding that the proposed development sites are NOT consistent with the nation policy, specifically with regard to green belt. Leeds must continue to protect our green spaces. These spaces are important to me because we often enjoy walking and exercising in these areas and feel that new development focus should be on brownfield sites, not green belt.

The proposed development site are not consistent with the national policy, specifically with regard to infrastructure. Leeds has insufficient policies in place to address the issues that these developments will generate. Development and infrastructure must be considered side by side.

The city has no current plan to solve traffic problems along the affected areas and already the traffic is an absolute nightmare. Much of the A65 can be widened but consideration has been given to the bottle necks around the roundabout at Horsforth and going down and over the cancel and railways. There may be two lanes coming down the ring road but this goes down to two and cannot cope with any more traffic as it stands - never mind when the development of the old clarinet site is completed. The only alternative routes are via Apperley bridge or Armley both already grid locked at rush hour. All three bridges would need replacing to cope with the traffic.... Will the developers pay for this level of work?

Please keep me informed of the public examinations, submission of the plans and potential outcome of the review as I would like to retain my right to attend and speak.

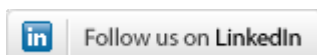
