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I am contacting you to register my objection to the plan to build houses on green fields at Gill Lane and the A65 in Yeadon (HG2-10 (1221) Gill Lane).

The A65 has been getting busier and there are frequent jams - the proposed building of these houses would cause further jams and delays, and increase the chance of accidents.

I have given up trying to turn right at the bottom of the road and regularly have to turn left at the bottom of our road if i want to go to Guiseley (a right turn) to avoid a 5 minute wait. I have to go to the roundabout to get on to the other side of the road, as the Westfield entrance/exit is opposite our road and there are long waits and often near misses with people trying to get out..

I understand the traffic survey was carried out by David Wilson Homes in half term, which would not have given a true representation of the usual traffic flow. The schools in the area are overloaded at present, both St Peter & Pauls and Benton Park (and St Marys Menston) have all extended their schools to cope with the existing number of pupils.

With the number of additional people these houses would bring; the schools, doctors surgeries, dentists, vets would be overwhelmed, to say nothing about the wear and tear on the road itself, and the safety aspect. Repairs and closures would be horrendous.

I understand that this area is a conservation area with historical trees and hedgerows, all of which would disappear if the project went ahead.

Please take time to reconsider these houses for an area which is underused instead of making our lives harder than they need to be.
