Date Dear Sir / Madam,

I am writing this objection on behalf of my children. As part of the Leeds Site Allocation Plan public consultation, I would like to formally object to the proposed development of the following sites: HG2-41(4240), HG2-42 (1016) and HG2-43 (5009) on their behalves.

It is our understanding that the proposed development sites are NOT consistent with the national policy, specifically with regard to Green Belt. Leeds must continue to protect our Green Belt and greenfields.

The fields and open green spaces, which are being proposed for development, are important to me for many reasons. Our parents chose to move to Horsforth for the mixture of shops, bars, restaurants, Hall Park, as well as the surrounding green space. We have lived on the edge of the College campus and feel extremely sad that this land is likely to be turned over to make way for housing. We have enjoyed many walks around the areas proposed for development and feel extremely upset that this landscape may not be around for much longer if these proposed plans are implemented.

We often drive via the A65 from Horsforth towards Rawdon/Guiseley and love the views that we have on our doorstep. We like to travel to Ilkey this way, and believe that we are likely to spend so much of our time stuck in the traffic in the car, adding further damage to the environment.

These sites should continue to be part of Leeds' 'Strategic Green Infrastructure' as identified in the Adopted Core Strategy.

We believe that the proposed development sites are NOT consistent with the national policy, specifically with regard to infrastructure. Leeds has insufficient policies in place to address the issues that these developments will generate. Development and infrastructure requirements must be considered side by side.

Development of these sites on greenfields will lead to nearby villages being engulfed within the 'Main Urban Area' and they will no longer be separate 'Major Settlements' of their own. Reference, Adopted Core Strategy (Map 3, Settlement Hierarchy).

We already get stuck in lots of traffic to and from our way to nursery in Rodley, and anymore houses are going to cause even longer delays and environmental impact.

I would like to be kept me informed of the public examinations, submission of the plans and potential outcome of the review as I would like to retain my right to attend and speak.
