I wish to strongly object to the proposals laid out for greenbelt areas in Rawdon. In particular HG3-4 which contains an area of ancient woodland, Ghyll Beck, and a large population of Bluebells which, as I am sure that you are aware, is now a protected species. Building adjacent to this can only be detrimental to this habitat and should not take place at any cost.

Also HG2-12 is not legally compliant as no on-site consultation took place prior to it being placed on the site allocation plan.

Overall no mention at all has been made regarding the way that all the extra traffic will be able to cope in a situation where long queues of traffic down to Horsforth roundabout are the norm despite the new traffic signals and road layout at the latter.

Please reconsider these plans they are just not workable or justified.

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
