Dear Sir/Madam, I would like to object to the proposed developments : HG2-41 (4240), HG2-42(1016), HG2-43(5009)

The development of these sites does not agree with National policy (NPPF) regarding green belts. They should remain part of Leeds's ' Strategic Green Infrastructure' as identified in the Adopted Core Strategy.

We need green spaces to stop the urban sprawl which is expanding .Our villages,such as Rawdon and Yeadon would be swallowed up,(ref Adopted Core Strategy Map 3, Settlement Hierarchy) We would have more pollution, more traffic congestion along the A65 in particular (it is bad enough now - I use the Horsforth roundabout daily and even when it's not rush hour the queues are long) I do not believe Leeds has sufficient policies in place to tackle these problems.

As a resident of Horsforth for over 30 years I've enjoyed the access to fresh air, walking ,wildlife (particularly birds) and local produce (strawberries, asparagus) in these proposed site developments. My kids have benefited from these green spaces and I would like their kids to do the same. I am a Mancunian by birth and one of the major benefits of living in Horsforth is the feeling of being almost in the countryside - it would be a great shame to lose it.
