I am very concerned about the proposed housing developments HG2-41, HG2-43, HG2-12, HG3-2, HG3-3, HG3-4. These are greenfield sites and we love living on the edge of Leeds next to fields. These fields enable us to escape to the countryside without using a car. This green space is good for our emotional and physical wellbeing.

The traffic around here is getting worse and worse and with all this additional housing then the roads will be gridlocked. Schools are already oversubscribed and so existing schools cannot accommodate any additional families. There are many houses already being built in the former Clariant Site off the ring road which have been given an LS18 post code. When these houses are fully occupied then we will already have far too much traffic. Not to mention the many, many houses due to be built at Kirkstall Forge which will impinge on our route into Leeds City centre massively.

The proposal to include green belt sites in the local plan is not consistent with national policy. Please use brownfield before even considering to use green belt sites. The proposal to use this strategic green infrastructure goes against the Leeds core strategy.
