I am writing to object most strongly to the proposal of Leeds City Council to build houses on our Green Belt Land.

The sites I am concerned about are the following:-

HG2-12 Fields at Woodlands Drive Rawdon
HG3-2, HG3-3, HG3-4 Fields off A65, Rawdon
HG2-41 Fields South of A65, Horsforth roundabout to the crematorium
HG2-43 Fields at Horsforth College Campus

It is my understanding that the Green Belt sites included in the local plans are not consistent with the national policy. To use the Green Belt land before brownfield sites is both outrageous and totally unjustified.

The proposal to use the Strategic Green Infrastructure goes against Leeds Core Strategy.

I and my family have lived in Rawdon for thirty eight years and have supported the local Church, s#hools and businesses. We came to this area to embrace village life and have walking access to the beautiful countryside. The proposals will take away our quality of life as we will become part of the urban sprawl with no identity.

We live adjacent to the A65 and whilst we appreciate LCC efforts to solve the very heavy congestion caused by the ever growing number of vehicles using this road, unfortunately it has not alleviated the problems. By allowing the building of several hundred houses without due regard to the already existing infra-structure will severely damage everyone's quality of life. .

If these proposals go ahead over the coming years, the noise and pollution caused by the numbers of queuing vehicles will be amplified by the loss of the green belt land and our health and well-being will suffer together with that of future generations.
