As part of the Leeds Site Allocation Plan public consultation process I would like to formally object to the proposed development of the following sites

HG2-41 (4240)
HG2 -42 (1016)
HG2-43 (5009)
HG2-12 (4254)

It is my belief that the proposed development sites are Not consistent with the national policy, specifically with regard to green belt. Leeds must protect our green belt and green fields for all to enjoy in future years.

The fields which are proposed for building of houses are very important to myself and family regarding the green spaces around our neighbourhood. Any development would endeavour to cause so much more traffic on such a busy road out of the city and bottlenecks are visible all day long. We are already building over 2000 new homes in the area.

The infrastructure must be considered Leeds has insufficient policies in place to address the issues that these developments will generate
Development and infrastructure must be considered side by side.

Development of these sites on green fields will lead to nearby villages being engulfed within the "Main Urban Area" and will no longer be separate major settlements of their own. Reference, Adopted Core Strategy (Map 3, Settlement Hierarchy)

We have enough brown fields sites around the city to be considered for housing
Horsforth used to be a desirable area but every spare piece of land has been built on over the years. I understand a new road to the airport is also on future plans
