Dear Leeds City Council, REF SITE HG2-124

I do not support the proposed development of the Stourton Grange South site, ref: HG2-124, and I believe its inclusion in the Site Allocations Plan renders the plan unsound.

The Stourton Grange Farm South site is at an elevated position above the town. It is open fields with wide open views across it. It doesn't have much by way of boundary landscaping (trees or hedgerows) so the impact of new development will be quite noticeable. Does Stourton Grange Farm South therefore represent the best choice for Garforth?

An alternative site exists to the north of the railway line to the east of Garforth – Sturton Grange North. This site does not have the impediments of Stourton Grange Farm South and is a more suitable site. I request that the Council consider this site as a more appropriate and sound option for this part of the District.

New recreation facilities within this area can only benefit the locality by giving the local football & rugby teams a new home. It would also be a massive boost to the redeveloped Leeds ladies football team, at last giving them a home. Also giving the people of Garforth & its surrounding areas facilities to be proud of.

I urge the Council to remove the Stourton Grange South site from the SAP and instead include the proposed Sturton Grange North site.
