I am fearful that the infrastructure of the area cannot cope NOW so what will it be like with the addition of more families. cars etc.

The A65 is a nightmare. I collect my grandchildren from Rawdon Littlemoor School. I need to drive for medical reasons and this is an horrific journey. The car park is inadequate so parents arrive early to queue on to the main road to await the gates being unlocked at 3 pm. There are cars and children everywhere. Then trying to exit on to the A65 is another long queue. The school is full to capacity now so where will the new children be educated.

I dread the thought that there will be NO green spaces for my children and grandchildren to enjoy. Life revolves now around sitting in queues of slow moving vehicles. There is no such thing as "the rush hour" on the roads. Every hour is so busy! What about the wildlife? There will be no suitable habitat. The wonderful old stone buildings which are our legacy will be swamped by little boxes which will not be suitable for the outstanding delight of the area now. A concrete jungle is no heritage.

As a resident of many years I feel that the pressure on Schools, Doctors' Surgeries, Dentists etc. has not been addressed. Neither have many other issues. Will there be an adequate clean water supply and can the sewers be relied upon to cope with the extra load?

Please think again and don't just be guided by the financial incentive. Do you have the right to destroy the beauty of the countryside? You are robbing the next generation of so much that we have enjoyed. Don't have that on your conscience.
