I wish to lodge my concern's about the extensive Green Belt building proposals in the Rawdon and Horsforth areas namely

HG2-12 Fields at Woodlands Drive
HG3-2, Hg3-3,Hg3-4 Fields off the A65 Rawdon
HG2-41 Fields South of the A65 , Horsforth roundabout to the crematorium
HG2-43 Fields at the Horsforth college campus

The above proposed Green Belt planning consents are not consistent with the National policy. The proposals to use Green Field sites before Brown Field sites have been exhausted is not justified . Furthermore the proposal to use this Strategic Green Infrastructure goes against the Leeds Core Strategy.

The loss of any of the above Green Belt sites will have an adverse effect on the quality of life of thousands of residents in the local areas of Horsforth and Rawdon by choking the roads which are presently over loaded at peak times and placing a strain on the local facilities such as the Doctors ,Dentists and schools . The loss of Green Belt land will reduce the unique village feeling we have in Rawdon in particular if the boundaries are virtually joined together by modern new build sites that lack character .

In the strongest of terms I wish to object to any of the above sites being allowed to be sacrificed to new build sites
