A brief outline of our objections:-

The overcrowding on the A660 would be totally uncontrollable due to the ridiculous number of cars exiting to and fro from the 441 on the various sites. Most houses will have two or more cars.

The huge number of houses would completely destroy Bramhope as its' present comfortable village, being classified as a small settlement.

On site HG2 - 17 (1080 3367A) there appears to be one entrance into the proposed estate onto Breary Lane East. this road is not suitable for the volume of traffic this development would create. This traffic would be joining Creskeld lane on an almost right angled bend!! Can you imagine the danger to children in the vicinity and the number of vehicle accidents considering there is no street lighting.

There would be an unacceptable loss of green belt and green fields.

The infrastructure would not cope with such an increase in housing.

Dreadful effects upon local ecology, landscape and not least the ' conservation area'!!

As mentioned the whole rural character of the village would be destroyed, bearing in mind that many within Bramhope have paid considerable sums to live in a peaceful environment.

These proposals should be thrown out, not least as there is a lack of up to date demographic evidence to support such proposals.
