I am writing to object to the proposed housing at Gill Lane, Nether Yeadon 1221(HG2-10)

The proposed 155 houses on this site will fill the only green land that now exists on the A65 in Aireborough, It is greenbelt and should be protected from developers. It currently is farmed and has grazing animals on it..The traffic from the houses planned to be built on this site, will feed out onto the A65 and Gill Lane. The A65 is already heavily congested and this site is only a couple of hundred yards from the JCT Roundabout, which is congested. When the new station is opened in Apperley Bridge this roundabout will be gridlocked. There has been no joint planning with Bradford Council and that authority has already given planning permission for many new houses in Apperley Bridge and Greengates. The local schools are full, so are the doctors and dentists and there is no provision for provide more. There are no plans to improve the roads or bus services. The pollution from all of this traffic is a health hazard and there are two schools nearby, so this pollution will affect the children. No new employment is planned for Aireborough which means that more people will commute to Leeds and Bradford.

There are plenty of brown field sites in Leeds; all of our brownfield land has been built on already. Over 2000 house have already been built in Aireborough in the past 10 years.
