This development will be difficult to sustain in the location allocated and will cause absolute havoc and danger on the traffic volumes on the A660 both in the construction phase and the finished development and the access onto the A660. Into Leeds via Headingley with its already severe congestion which would make it a complete nightmare for the travelling public, the developments already done or in the process at Bodington Hall and the adjacent government buildings along with the development completed at Adel will all add to the impact of this situation. I feel also that this development would add to pollution and ill health as this will over-populate the area and at present we only have one medical centre in the village. What about primary schools and secondary schools also, this could be a problem in itself. I feel that building on this scale in a village environment is completely inappropriate. The saying "Not in My Back Garden" is always going to be a relevant saying but an overview of all aspects of these proposed developments should be uppermost in your mind as we are the ones that have to live with the consequences during development and thereafter. I feel that this will also spoil the community spirit in Bramhope of which we are proud, such as Bramhope in Bloom and other small activities run on a village setting.
