I wish lodge to my concerns regarding planning applications Reference Numbers: HG2-12 & HG2-41.

Also HG3-2 , HG3-3 and HG3-4

I have a number of problems with this and would urge you to reconsider:

A. The terminal and permanent loss of some beautiful swathes of Leeds landscape, greenbelt, mature trees and woods.

When its gone, its gone. That's it. Is this the legacy we want to leave future generations?

It's pretty obvious that, despite national planning policy intentions, brownfield sites across Leeds have been discounted in favour of areas more attractive to developers, yielding higher council tax returns to the local authority.

B. Additional congestion on the A65 - Its bad enough already. Perhaps councilors might like to the sample the crawl towards Leeds between Knott Lane and the ring road roundabout at 8 o'clock on a work day morning.

C. I have a naive view that it is the role of elected local government to protect its citizens from the voracious greed of those that would exploit us to the detriment of ourselves and our environment. Apparently not in this case. the lack of open consultation is staggering. Most of us have only found out about this through local campaigners . This is especially true of HG2-12. If this is the way you engage with your constituents you should be ashamed of yourselves.
