Dear Sir or Madam,

I wish to object to the proposed development of the greenbelt and allotment sites HG 2-5 Coach Road and HG 2-6 Allotments.

I am a local resident living very close to the sites of the proposed development and I believe they will have a negative impact on my everyday life and enjoyment of the area.

My objections are as follows:

The main objection to the building of houses and school on the Coach Road and Allotments development is that our only access road, Silverdale Avenue, has cars parked on both sides of the road which makes it virtually a one-lane street. Cars queueing to get out into Park Road prevent cars from turning into Silverdale Avenue causing a tailback which with the increased volume of traffic caused by any new development will result in queues all the way back to the A65.

All traffic entering or leaving the Silverdale estate has to come in from Park Road which is extremely busy currently because Morrisons Supermarket, Busy Bees Nursery access directly, and Guiseley school, Tranmere Park and Fieldhead estates also use this road. During rush hour cars are standing from the A65 to Bradford Road creating a polluted atmosphere for the children who walk along it.

The Green Belt should not be made available for development to encourage developers to build on brown field sites. The need now is for affordable housing and any houses built on the green belt will be unaffordable for first time buyers.

Doctors surgeries are already over crowded and doctors seem to be leaving for less stressful medical practise elsewhere.
