The Linton Village Society (LVS) is generally supportive of LCC in the consultation process that has taken place and the positive manner in which the documentation has been prepared.

In particular the emphasis on sustainable transport guidance contained in the NPPF and the 12 core planning principles which require new growth to make the fullest possible use of public transport, walking and cycling, and focus significant development in locations which are or can be made sustainable is in harmony with the principles of the LVS.

The LVS believes that in addition all local proposals for development must not be contrary to policies of the Core Strategy, the guidance contained within the SPG 'Neighbourhoods for Living' and the guidance within the National Planning Policy Framework.

The LVS also believes that future development, particularly in LINTON, must consider the impact on existing trees, potential ecological implications as well as the special landscape of the area.

We therefore fully support Site MX2-33 (Headley Hall) as this in our opinion meets all of these criteria.

However, we consider Site HG3-7(The Ridge) to be totally unsuitable as it is contrary to all the above principles.
