This is green belt land and I object to it being built on and lost for future generations. Green space is extremely important, by building on this land you are contributing to urban sprawl, destroying wildlife habitats and creating further congestion (roads) in an already terribly congested area.

Horsforth cannot take any more housing, our roads are constantly blocked (single track ring way), our schools are full and so are our NHS services.

I urge you not to build houses in our area in greenbelt land and only build on brown field with a significant investment in infrastructure and services.
