Dear Leeds Council

I am writing to raise my objection to the proposal to build on Green Belt land.

I am particularly concerned about the following sites:

- HG2-41, Fields South of A65, Horsforth roundabout to crematorium
- HG43 Fields at Horsforth College Campus
- HG2-12 Fields at Woodlands Drive, Rawdon
- HG3-2, HG3-3, HG3-4, Fields off A65, Rawdon.

The proposal to include these Green Belt sites in the Local Plan is NOT consistent with the national policy.

The proposal to use Green Belt before brownfield is not justified.

The proposal to use this Strategic Green Infrastructure goes against the Leeds Core Strategy.

Surely building on fields is counter to the stated ambition of Leeds becoming a Child Friendly City.

This is an important area to me and my family. This area helps me and my family with our wellbeing, health and exercise. They are necessary for the future.

Please do not build on these sites.
