Hello

I would like to raise my concerns over the new site allocation plans for the Aireborough area.

I have grown up in Yeadon, now live in Guiseley and work in Rawdon. Over the past 10 years I have seen at least 7 new housing developments built. This does bring people to the area and adds to the economy. However I have also seen the downsides.

Introducing more houses and cars to these areas before fixing/improving matters first is outrageous.

Roads are busier than ever, in particular the A65. Most weekends and rush hours this road can be full of traffic jams and a chaotic West Side Retail Park. Introducing more houses and cars to an already troubled road will just bring it to a halt.

Schools - In the last two years schools have been running beyond maximum capacity, what were only Primary and Junior schools have had to increase to Full Schools to cope with current demands, some are just temporary units. How can you populate the area more without introduce more schools.

An additional 234 houses are being planned behind Shaw Lane/Banksfield Mount increasing the traffic on Coppice Wood Avenue, where I live, with potentially 468 cars, this road is already busy, is an access bus route and has a school on it. Speed is 20 miles per hour in some sections of the road. Having this many additional cars to a small residential area is potentially putting lives at risk.

I can't see how the introduction of more houses to an area which is already running a maximum capacity with Schools and Doctor Surgeries, and over crowded roads will help the situation. We need to create more schools/doctors and roads or widen existing roads before re-population can occur.

I hope my concerns will be taken into consideration.
