Dear Sir,

I wish to object to the following planning applications:

HG2 - 15 (3400) Green Acres and Equestrian Centre

HG2 - 16 (1002) Creskeld Lane, Bramhope

HG2 - 17 (1080) Breary Lane East, Bramhope

1 The planned housing is inappropriate to the needs of the area. Large luxury housing may line the builders pockets but is not suitable as either affordable family housing or to meet the needs of Bramhopes ageing population.

2 Where are all these new people going to find jobs? Certainly not in Bramhope, they will all need to commute on the already seriously over congested A660.

3 The huge increase in population would have a devastating effect on the character of Bramhope, the local school and doctors are already overstretched. If a new school is built who will be funding this?

4 The applications cover some of the Bramhope conservation area.

5 No green field sites should be built on while brown field sites are available. There are also a huge number of empty properties which should be renovated and bought back into use. This would significantly reduce the need for new builds.

6 The building would have a devastating effect on the local ecology. Bramhope has thriving bird and mammal population which would be lost if the building goes ahead. The adjacent site Spring Wood (3367B) which is an amazing bluebell wood would be ruined if access was made easier by building houses next to it. Once green fields are built on they are gone for ever. No amount of "new habitat" ever replaces the existing ecosystem.
