I wish to record my opposition to the proposed housing developments in the areas around Woodlands Drive, Knott Lane, Layton Lane, Rawdon Crematorium and the Horsforth roundabout on the following grounds:

- There has been no adequate consultation with residents
- There is no evidence that Leeds City Council is actively meeting its responsibility to encourage the use of brown field land.
- The proposal would destroy the greenbelt and would remove the identity of Rawdon and Horsforth as separate and viable communities and would consequently reduce the quality of life for those communities.
- There would be a negative impact on general amenity
- There would be a negative impact on wildlife
- The already dreadful traffic situation and its attendant air pollution would be made worse.
- Good quality, productive arable and grazing land would be destroyed at a time when the country is just waking up to increased desirability of being more self-sufficient in terms of food production.
- There is no evidence of the sustainability of these new, enlarged communities.
- The projected population growth data for the area is out of date and exaggerated.
