Dear Sir,

I am writing to register my strong objections to the plans to build housing on the sites HG2-12 and HG2-41 on Green Belt land in the Horsforth/Rawdon area.

My objections are as follows :-

1. The requirement to build over 70,000 houses in the Leeds area is based on outdated information, The calculation using updated figures indicates a requirement for a figure nearer to 50,000.
2. Therefore, the need for extra homes can be met by greater use of Brown Field land and not using Green Belt land which is against National Policy and Leeds Core Strategy.
3. The development of housing on these sites would place even more pressure in the local schools, medical services, roads and infrastructure along the A65 and in the Horsforth area.
4. The site at HG2-41, known locally as Strawberry Fields, is particularly important as a green belt site between the new Horsforth Vale development and the A65.
