As part of the Leeds site allocation plan public consultation process , I want to formally object to the proposed development on these sites:

HG2-9 (3366)

HG2-12 (4054) and (4254)

HG2-41 (4240)

HG2-42 (1016)

HG2-43 (5009)

Its my understanding that these proposed sites aren't consistent with the national policy, specifically in regards to greenbelt. Leeds must carry on protecting our greenbelt and green fields for the future.

The open green spaces and fields being proposed are important to me because of the wildlife that have these places as there home, and as places of natural beauty that has a positive impact on the area and the people who live hear as well as myself. Keeping these places undeveloped gives people a space to enjoy even in passing by, but to also be able to walk and relax and enjoying being able to see and hear animals like deer and owls. Places like this are important for people to have around. The loss of these habitats, busier more dangerous roads and extra pollution in the area because of these will have a big negative impact. These sites should continue to be part of Leeds' strategic greenfield infrastructure for the future as identified in the adopted core strategy.

Its also in my understanding that the proposed sites do not fit with national policy in regards to infrastructure. Leeds plans for another 70,000 homes is far too high a figure for recent population figures, and these will merge towns into one another without the proper plans (if any) to improve areas already struggling. There is already bad traffic along certain roads like the A65, not all of which can be widened and will cause more problems with bottle necks, and will be made more hazardous to drivers and pedestrians. Doctors, dentists and schools are going to be overwhelmed as well, and needing to improve these just as much as new houses.

Please keep me informed of the public examinations, submission of the plans and potential outcome of the review, as I would like to retain my right to attend and speak.
