Dear sir/madam,

I write to object in the strongest possible terms to your proposal to build on several green belt sites. I am particularly concerned about the proposals for HG2-12 fields at woodlands drive in Rawdon, HG3-2, HG3-4 fields off the A65 in Rawdon, HG2-41 fields south of the A65, Horsforth roundabout to the Crematorium and HG2-43 fields at Horsforth college campus.

The proposal to include these Green Belt sites in the Local Plan is NOT consistent with the national policy.

The proposal to use Green Belt before brownfield is not justified.

The proposal to use this Strategic Green infrastructure goes against the Leeds Core Strategy.

These areas are areas of great natural beauty, vital as wild life habitats and vital as places for local people to use and enjoy. I walk every day around the green belt areas of Rawdon with my dogs and regularly meet many other people of all ages, all enjoying these beautiful places. Losing these stunning open spaces would be devastating to so many.
