I am writing to object strongly to the proposed building of approx 8,689 homes in the Horsforth, Rawdon, Yeadon, Guiseley, Menston, Hawksworth, Carlton, Calverley areas. This will have a huge impact on the quality of life of all people who currently live in these areas, mainly because the infrastructure is not being put in place first before these homes are to be built.

There will not be enough school places, waiting times to see a doctor are already too long, with the essential services already stretched I do not understand how this will work with the added huge rise in population.

The A65 is already congested, and journeys to work can already be slow, so I cannot imagine what the roads will be like with 14,000+ more cars. Leeds is continually being overlooked for a decent public transport network like the tram system that was shelved a number of years ago, so I think the traffic will be an absolute nightmare.

I am also really concerned about the use of Green Belt land to build these houses on. I thought the whole point of land being classified as green belt is so it is protected. This area has beautiful scenery and green spaces, which I think are vitally important to keep hold of for a thriving community such as the Aireborough district.

Altogether I feel that an influx of thousands and thousands more people into the area all using amenities that are already overstretched, and an already congested road network is unthinkable without plans to put the infrastructure in place to manage this first.
