To Members of Leeds City Council,

I am writing to express my concern and objections to proposed house building on Horsforth's green belt.

I am particularly concerned about sites:

HG2-41 Fields South of A65, Horsforth roundabout to the crematorium

HG2-43 Fields at Horsforth College Campus

HG2-12 Fields at Woodlands Drive, Rawdon

HG3-2, HG3-3, HG3-4 Fields off A65, Rawdon

I feel that the proposal to include these Green Belt sites in the local plan is NOT consistent with national policy and any proposal to use Green Belt sites before brown field is not in any way acceptable or justified.

Also the proposal to use this strategic Green infrastructure goes against the Leeds Core Strategy.

To conclude my objections, I would like to remind the members of Leeds City Council that although we need housing, human beings also need green spaces for their psychological and physical well being. I would also like to ask the council to remember it has a duty to preserve the quality of life of the people already living in Horsforth and therefore should restrict building to brownfield sites and protect our precious Green Belt to ensure it is there for future generations.
