I am particularly concerned about site allocations HG2-12—Fields at Woodlands Drive Rawdon, HG3-2, HG3-3, HG3-4, Fields off A65, Rawdon. HG2-41, Fields South of A65, Horsforth roundabout to the Crematorium, HG2-43, Fields at Horsforth College campus. These are all sites in the green belt and the proposal to include these sites in the Local plan is NOT consistent with the national policy.

The proposal to build on Green Belt before Brownfield cannot be justified.

The NPPF states that Green belt boundaries should only be altered in exceptional circumstances and the Leeds core strategy has not taken account of this as brownfield sites are available and should be used in preference.

I and my family have enjoyed our green areas for some 50 years or so for our dog walking and general health and exercise. We wish to continue to use this in the future. These green areas also help to keep our air a little cleaner and fresher considering the toxic pollution emanating from the severely congested A65 as well as that which “rains” down upon us from air traffic using the Leeds and Bradford airport. Please take account of this letter in my opposition to the Leeds City Council plans to destroy our precious green fields.
