Dear Sir or Madam

This is to register a strong objection to the proposed development for residents in Church Lane paddock/Holy Trinity Glebe Field in Meanwood. This green space does not have appropriate access for either Fire, Police or Ambulance services - so this would unnecessarily endanger residents there.

Also the road infra-structure of the whole Meanwood area, with Church Lane, Parkside Road and Green Road in particular, are already all at overload with traffic which has increased exponentially due to the various developments in the old Meanwood Hospital site and the Waitrose and the Retail Park on Stonegate Road.

The volume of traffic is higher than the Meanwood system is able to deal with and the cars drive too fast and are a danger to all the children in the area.

In addition, the congestion and number of cars parked on the pavements causes hazards for the elderly, who cannot have free pavement access, and for those with pushchairs and young children - all very unsatisfactory on a health and safety level.

All of the traffic, number of parked cars would be further increased if this proposed development were to proceed, so I register my strongest objection against it please.
