Horsforth Proposed Sites: HG2-41, HG2-42, HG2-43, HG2-37, HG2-12, HG3-3, HG3-2, HG3-4, EG1-5

I write to raise my concerns in relation to the above proposed development sites on greenfield sites within the Leeds green belt.

I have lived in Leeds my entire life. I am very proud of the city and Yorkshire in general. One of Leeds' greatest assets is the green belt which means that within a 20 minutes radius of the city centre you find yourself in open countryside. It is something that countless people visiting Leeds from other parts of the UK have commented on to me and something that we must fight to protect.

I fully appreciate that more houses need to be built in Leeds. However, just because large corporate house building companies want to build those houses on greenfield sites which will yield larger profits for them does not mean that they should be allowed to do so.

Leeds City Council has a duty and a legal obligation to protect greenfield sites and the green belt. To permit the construction of houses on the sites listed above would be in breach of the National Planning Policy Framework and the Leeds Core Strategy.

I trust that you will reconsider permitting the construction of properties on these sites in light of the overwhelming opposition to these proposals within the Horsforth area and Leeds generally.
